

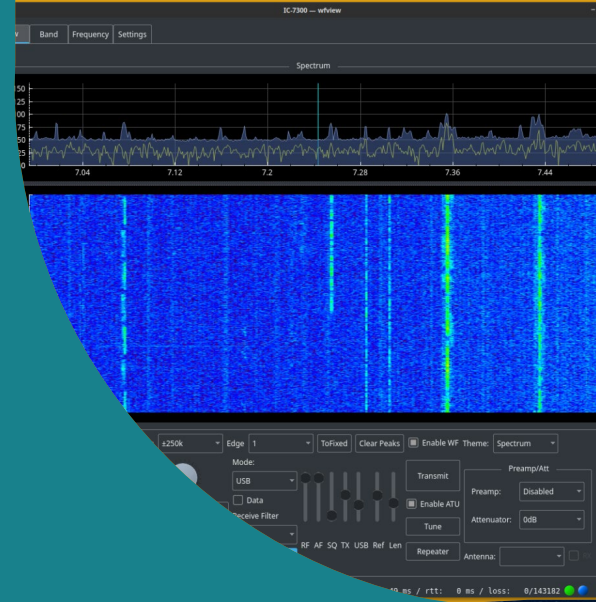

What is WFVIEW?



- Solid Remote Control Software, more stable than Icom's own RS-BA1 solution
- Makes Remoting Icom Radios Easy
- Controlling Radio with Mouse Is Clumsy
- Having Solid Buttons and Knobs is a Plus



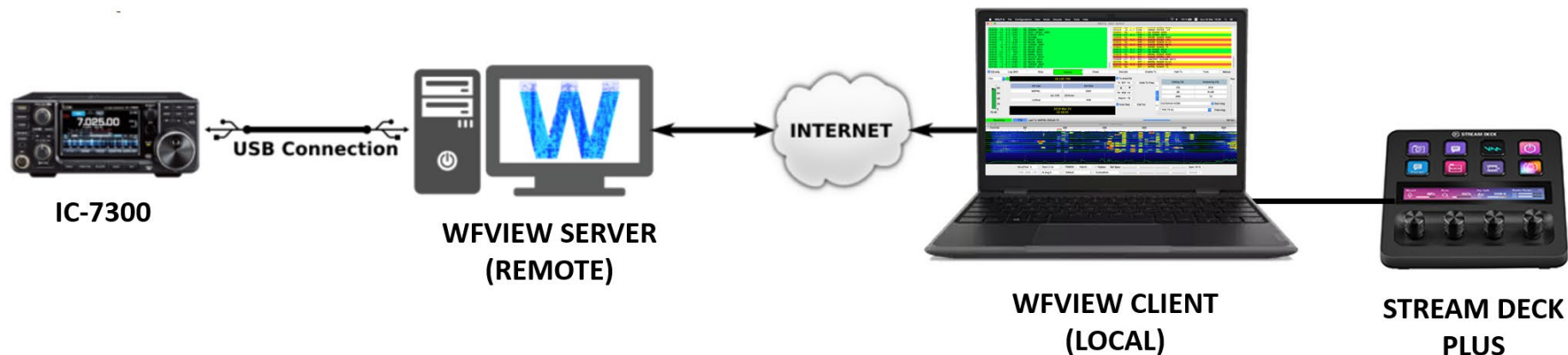


WFVIEW

- This quick explanation of the wfview implementations and not designed to be a how-to.
- There are quite a few how-to videos out.
- Ed James, KA8JMW has a detailed how-to on connecting the software to your PC and remoting an Icom IC-7300 with a Streamdeck+. It will be in Course Syllabus with this presentation.
- Significant functionality is being “glossed over” in this quick talk

Icom IC-7300

- IC-7300 is connected to a remote PC running WFVIEW software via USB.
- The local client uses the Remote PC and WFVIEW to connect to the radio over the internet.



StreamDeck +



- Can be used for all options on wfview
 - VFOA/VFOB
 - Waterfall/Spectrum
 - Volume
 - RF Gain
 - TX Power
- Multiple “pages” of options can be addressed
 - Common use on front page
 - Less common on second page

How to configure buttons

You do not need to load any drivers, the WFview software polls and operates the Streamdecks directly.
